

Spelling - Practise your spellings every week for the test on Friday. They will be sent home with you so you can ask an adult to test you!




Please help your child by making sure they have a quiet space to complete their home learning weekly tasks and helping them remember which day to bring their work in to school.

HOME LEARNING PROJECTS FOR THE AUTUMN TERM

1. Tudor Menu

What did wealthy Tudors eat?
Research and create a 3 course Tudor menu.



2. Tudor House

Have a go at making your own Tudor house. What do these words mean and what do they have to do with Tudor houses?

Jetty, wattle, daub, timber.



3. Tudor Peppermint Creams

-Mix 250g icing sugar, 1 egg white and 2 - 3 drops of peppermint essence in a bowl to form a dough.
-Divide the mixture into 20 small balls and press them flat. Leave in the fridge for 30 minutes.
-Drizzle melted dark chocolate on top (optional)



4. Diary of a Tudor

Write a diary by a famous Tudor.
(E.g. Elizabeth I, Henry VIII, Anne Boleyn...)

How would they be feeling? What secrets would they write about?



5. Tudor Rose

Design or make a Tudor Rose.
You could use collage or crepe paper, or even paint or draw it.



6. The Mary Rose

What was the Mary Rose? Make a fact file about it.

- What was it?
- Who did it belong to?
- What happened to it?
- Include drawings.



7. Ships Salt Biscuits (not for eating!)

-Mix 250g plain flour, 125g table salt and 125 ml water to make a dough. Knead it until smooth.
-Shape the dough into biscuits shapes and bake in the oven at 120 degrees C for 3 hours.
-When they are cooled, you can paint them to decorate.
