Find out as much as you can about your house. Do you know when it was built? When did your family move there?

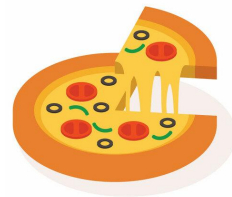


Find out about what happened in Norwich during the second World War.
