

## Building a Community- What is the Impact of Settling in One Place?

Throughout Year Three the overall Inquiry Question is about the impact of human settlement. In the summer term the children learn about the Ancient Civilization in Greece and the specific geographical conditions which shaped the development of culture. They will consider the legacy of the Ancient Greek civilization particularly through Greek myths and stories. The focus school values of **courage, creativity and patience** are explored through the inquiry.

Summer Term	<p>The civilization of Ancient Greece is the focus of the study:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Looking at the location of the Greek mainland and Islands and how its proximity to the sea influenced the way of life and the myths and stories of the culture.</li><li>• Reflecting on how Ancient Greece has a legacy in the modern world and identifying examples of this in our culture and society.</li><li>• Understanding the common beliefs of the Ancient Greek people and how these were reflected in the myths and stories they told each other.</li><li>• Relating these stories to our moral understanding today and reflecting on the similarities and differences and how our moral understanding has been influenced by Ancient Greek culture.</li></ul>
