

The West Earlham Estate- New Places and New Beginnings: What drives people to embark on journeys that involve danger or uncertainty?

Throughout Year Six the overall Inquiry Question is about change: What drives people to embark on journeys that involve danger or uncertainty? In the spring term the children learn about the building of the post war council estates, focussed on the West Earlham Estate. They will consider the lives of the people and the choices they had to make in moving out of their homes in central Norwich. The focus school values of **respect, kindness and patience** are explored through the inquiry.
