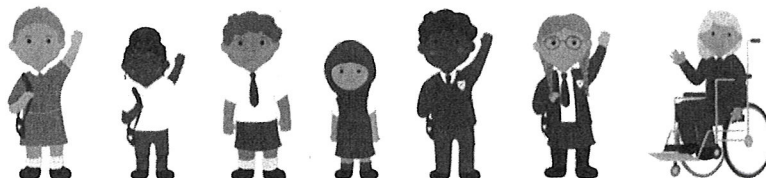

Thank you for supporting your school community. We look forward to seeing all of our smartly dressed pupils in the new school year.









Uniform Checklist: Autumn 2023

Uniform Checklist (School Dress Code)		
School Uniform 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black trousers (not leggings) • Black knee length skirt • Navy sweatshirt or navy cardigan with or without school logo • White or navy polo shirt with or without school logo • Black, navy or white socks or tights <p>Make sure ALL pieces of uniforms are named. This helps us to return any lost clothing. Thank you.</p>
Footwear		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plain black sensible shoes or trainers (no coloured logos or laces)
Optional Summer School Uniform		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blue and white striped/checked summer dress • Plain black, school shorts • Plain black sensible shoes or trainers • Sun hat
PE Kit		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plain white t-shirt • Plain black or navy shorts – no logos other than school logo • Black or navy plain tracksuit/joggers • Sensible trainers
Swimming (Y4, Y5 & Y6)		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trunks for boys • Swimming costume (one piece swimsuit) for girls • Towel
Hair & Jewellery		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All hair longer than shoulder length to be tied back at all times. • Stud earrings only which will need to be removed for P.E. • Wrist watch may be worn (no smart watches) • No other jewellery to be worn.
